Deduction – Disqualification 50-200 points

- ____1. Single base catches.
- ____2. Toe pitch flips.
- ____3. Any flip dismount to the ground UNLESS the flyer is in constant contact with their bases. Hip over head unassisted tosses i.e. barrel rolls with the exception of the University/Collegiate category.
- ____4. Any forward or backward rotation, free flight over, under or through any pyramid, partner stunt or object.
- ____5. Any forward or backward rotation from/during a basket toss with the exception of University/Collegiate Division 1 rotation is permitted.
- ____6. Double flips or 2 rotations, front or back from any stunt
- ____7. Youth division will not do more than 1 rotation (twist) Varsity/Co-Ed/University/Collegiate will not do more than 2 rotations from a toss or stunt.
- ____8. Youth will not twist from a single leg extension.
- ____9. Knee slams, drops, seat, thigh and split drops, UNLESS the weight is first born on the hands or feet to break the impact.
- ____10. Full prone tension falls to the ground.
- ____11. Vaults.
- ____12. Any tosses from a split position.
- ____13. Helicopters.
- ____14. All divisions are prohibited from doing free falling swan dives or swan dive catches.
- ____15. Any height enhancing equipment with the exception of a sprung floor.
- ____16. Shoes not worn.
- ____17. Illegal use of spotters (to the discretion of the judge).
- ____18. Fewer than three catchers where 3 are required.
- ____19. A mascot in a Cheer Routine or Stunt Routine.
- ____20. Wearing nylons or other slippery fabric. **To the discretion of the judges.**
- ____21. A base shall not assume a back bend position.
- ____22. Stunts will not be higher than 2 people for Youth/Varsity/Co-Ed and 2 ½ for University/Collegiate. Stunts may allow an intermediate person who does not bear weight on the stunt. I.E. A foot or hand may join stunt groups, but no pressure is to be placed on the joining hand or foot.
- ____24. Any flier who lands unsafely from a dismount onto the cheer surface.
- ____25. More than 30 people in Large and 15 in Small Divisions on the floor at one time during any routine
- ____26. Tossing signs in an unsafe manner endangering judges or spectators.

BOBBLES - MISTAKES – FALLS

MINOR BOBBLES/MISTAKES

Minor errors during technical skills (examples: hands down on tumbling, minimal weight bearing; obvious missed skills; shaky stunts/pyramids, incomplete twisting cradles; obvious errors during dance maneuvers; etc.) will result in a "1" point deduction for EACH mistake.

MAJOR MISTAKES

Major errors during technical skills (examples: falls from individual stunts; falls during tumbling skills; falls to floor during dance maneuvers) will result in a "5" point deduction for each mistake.

ONE POINT DEDUCTIONS:

- ____-Untied or unsafe shoelace length
- ____-Untidy appearance (per person)
- ____-Improper/Unsafe nail length

FIVE POINT DEDUCTIONS:

- ____-Chewing gum
- ____-Hair not pulled back/unsecured hair accessories
- ____-Eyeglasses falling off
- ____-Illegal use of mascot or Novelty performer.
- ____-Any team member performing outside the matted surface
- ____-Swearing
- ____-Stepping on any props during a routine (without clearing)

TEN POINT DEDUCTIONS:

- ____-Any jewelry
- ____-Objectionable/Offensive body markings (visible)
- ____-Use of any unspecified props in any routine (hats etc.)

FIFTEEN POINT DEDUCTIONS:

- ____-Any assistance from the stands during any routine
- ____-Any more than 5 persons in a basket toss (4 in CO-ED)
- ____-Touching judges with body or props
- ____-Wearing casts or splints, not including athletic supports

TWENTY POINT DEDUCTIONS:

- ____-Improper foot wear on team members
- ____-Improper athletic wear on team members
- ____-Any assistance from a coach during any routine
- ____-Any stunting/gymnastics/cheering on the sidelines before or during routine entry
- ____-Any flyer that lands unsafely from a dismount
- ____- Stunts that are performed/caught to close to the cheer surface (must be 12-16 inches from floor)
- ____- Basket Tosses that require the bases to move more than a foot in distance to catch the flyer
- ____- A Flyer landing on their stomach from a twist Dismount.
- ____- Anything deemed unsafe or offensive to judge's discretion

* Please note that points will be deducted for each time an infraction occurs.

* Please note that it is up to the discretion of the judge(s) to penalize anything they deem unsafe or offensive to a maximum of 20 points
